

WRITTEN DIRECTIONS FROM PIEDMONT AVE./GAYLEY ROAD DOWN INTO
THE FACULTY CLUB

- If you are coming from the South i.e. the Claremont Resort/HWY 24 or 13 area, get onto Piedmont Avenue which is the easterly border of the campus by the stadium & Greek Theater. (also known as Fraternity Row) This street changes its name to Gayley somewhere around the stadium, try not to worry, just get on the road that goes along the bottom (downhill) edge of the stadium.
- If you are coming from the North side i.e. the El Cerrito side of campus, then find Gayley Road and head in a southerly direction.
- The Haas business school is on this road, the driveway down towards the club is on the south side of the Haas business school. If you are coming from the north, turn right just after the Haas school, if you are coming from the south, do a "u-turn" just at the point where the landscaped median comes to an end. This will put you in a "turn only" lane heading downhill, this is what you want! There actually is a sign pointing to the Faculty Club at this point, but you are too busy trying not to hit someone to read it. Head down hill, & be careful!
- As the DRIVEWAY down the hill comes to a "Y", bear to the right as you are facing a tall white Optometry School building. (Minor Hall)
- JUST after the edge of the Minor Hall is a small driveway on your left. Turn left after the Minor Hall, BUT BEFORE THE BOX HEDGE.
- As you proceed down a short driveway, you will find yourself in sort of Cul de Sac with a large log cabin on your right. There are three TFC visitor spots here. Be sure to NOT to park in the "WFC" spot, they will have you ticketed, this is for the Women's Faculty Club, not us. You MUST get a Pass from us for your car, no matter what, or you will get a ticket.
- The Faculty Club is the shingle and stucco building with a tile roof just down hill from the log cabin. There is a back door entrance, however there is no sign, just head through the glass door after a few steps.
- If you get lost, call the TFC Hotel front desk (540-5678) and have them talk you through finding your way. Someone is always there to answer the phone. Do not call the Banquet or Catering office, as we will most likely be in the Hall, and not at our desk.
